Credo has addressed key aspects of 508-compliance for Web-based intranet and internet information and applications, such as pages in Credo can be used without requiring an associated stylesheet, color is not required to use the site effectively, headers are identified in data tables, and text alternatives are available for images and multimedia.

Credo is committed to compliance with disability aids, such as screen readers, and is taking necessary steps to meet these. Credo specifically includes in its online help, guidance for visually-impaired users (each page on Credo has hyperlinks specifically placed to enable users with screen readers to skip common navigation elements of our pages and jump to a page's main content; and guidance is also given on how to increase the font size when using common browsers).
